The ideal candidate will be an enthusiastic, flexible, highly competent, creative person who is comfortable not only with a traditional approach to church music, but also with other styles of music, and who is able to work collaboratively with others in these areas.

The candidate a passion for choral music and teaching, as well as piano/organ skills. The position will be supported by an accompanist on piano and organ. Remuneration will be commensurate with experience and training, based on established guidelines. MacKay United is in an exciting period of being in the first stages of evolving a broader vision for music. The interim Music Director will be eligible for the long-term position at a later date.

Other expectations include:

Hours: 8-10 hours per week.

On-site availability: Thursday evening and Sunday morning choir rehearsals, as well as at Sunday and other services. Weekly meetings with the Minister, and monthly meetings with the Worship Committee.

Planning: weekly planning meeting with the Minister, and proposing appropriate music in the context of service themes, from MacKay's music library and beyond.
